Accreditation Placement Rate Methodology

A graduate from the graduation cohort is considered eligible for placement unless they meet one of the five exemptions detailed below:

- a. The graduate is deceased
- b. The graduate is permanently disabled
- c. The graduate is deployed for military service/duty
- d. The graduate studied under a student visa and is ineligible for employment in the U.S.
- e. The graduate continued his/her education at an institution under the same ownership

The Salon Professional Academy includes students in the Placement Rate as employed by November 30 following the cohort in the Gainful Employment template.

State Placement Rate Methodology

A graduate is defined as a student who successfully completed their program within 100% of the published program length.

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- b. The graduate is permanently disabled
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- d. The graduate studied under a student visa and is ineligible for employment in the U.S.
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The Salon Professional Academy includes students in the Placement Rate as employed if they became employed in their field within 6 months of completion of the program and The Salon Professional Academy has been able to obtain confirmation of name and contact information of employer, average hours per week, and income bracket.
